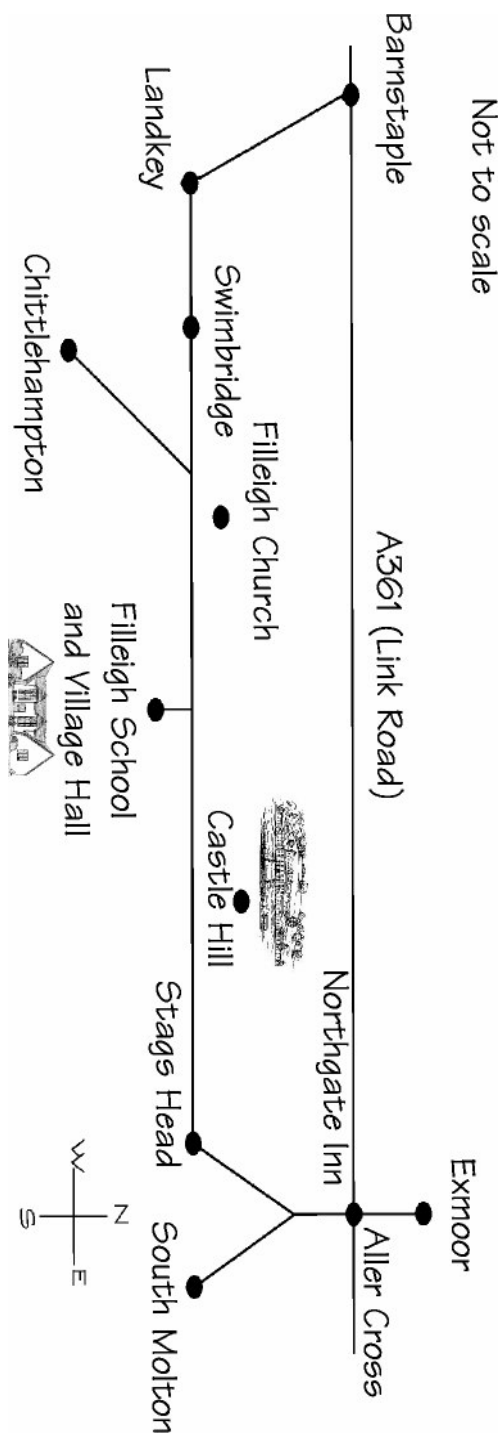

Filleigh Village Hall

Outside

An easily accessible location set in North Devon's lovely countryside, with plenty of good parking. The pleasing landscaped site includes a leisure area adjacent to the main hall, with a partially covered outdoor seating area. We are the first hall in North Devon to be awarded Hallmark 3.

Inside

The Foyer

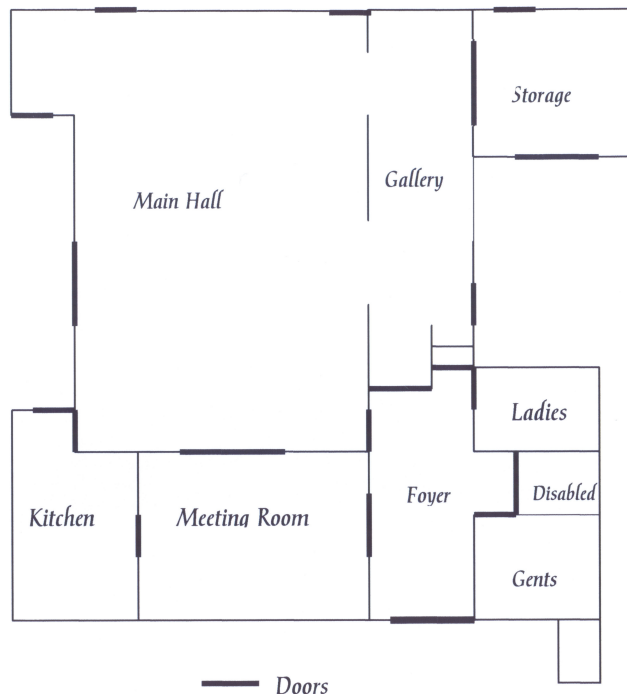
A pleasant and welcoming entrance, with easy access to the toilets and both the main hall and meeting room.

The Main Hall

Spacious, light and airy with under-floor heating for the cooler days and double doors opening out onto a sheltered covered patio area for the warmer ones. Semi-sprung floor, suitable for dances, dinners, conferences and badminton. There is a flexible, modular stage and blackout curtains.

The Hall is accessible to wheelchairs throughout.

A hearing loop and wireless internet access are available on request.



The Meeting Room

For the smaller group. Carpeted for comfort but with large folding doors so it can be used as an adjunct to the main hall. As with the main hall there are blackout curtains. There is a hearing loop in the meeting room

The Kitchen

Large and well planned, with plenty of work surfaces and sinks. It is equipped with a commercial pass-through dishwasher, three cookers, two microwaves, a fridge and a freezer, and china and cutlery for 200 people. There are hatches and doors to both the main hall and meeting room.

The Gallery

A side area of the main hall, accessed through archways and providing a pleasant 'sitting out' area with bar facilities if required.
